Disability consultancy service

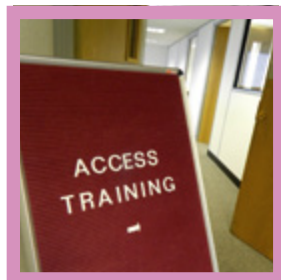
British Sign Language training
